

Recycle/Repurpose Ceramic Tiles

Supplies:

- Sandpaper (only for smooth surface ceramic tiles)
- Small Paint Roller/Paint Tray
- Primer (spray can for all purposes)
- Chalkboard paint (for a little extra you have colored chalkboard paint)
- Chalk
- Plate hanger for larger tiles to be hung.

Steps:

- 1) If you are using smooth surface ceramic tiles, slight sand the surface so primer will adhere.
- 2) Prime your tiles and allow 30 minutes to an hour to dry.
- 3) Chalkboard paint is very thick so make sure to stir it very well before pouring just enough to put 1 coat of paint on your tiles in the paint tray.
- 4) Then using your paint roller paint your tiles with chalkboard paint in 2 to 3 coats, waiting 3-4 hours between each coat.
- 5) Clean paint roller and tray between each coat. Dry roller well and put it in a Ziploc bag and put in the refrigerator to keep moist.
- 6) Wait 3 days before writing on your newly created chalkboard surface. Using the side of your chalk, rub it all over the surface and then wipe it off.
- 7) Viola! Your very own chalkboard surface to use for coasters, lists, notes etc.
